


How to Read Your Audit







Your degree audit may look a little intimidating, but it's much easier to read than you might think!







This chart shows you what the colors on your audit mean.



Completed: courses that you have taken and finished with a passing grade

In Progress: courses you are currently enrolled in

Unfulfilled: courses you still need to complete to graduate (courses that are not completed, not in progress, and not planned are unfulfilled)

Planned: planned courses will only show up on your audit if you specifically run an audit with planned courses





The first requirements you will see on your audit

- > MINIMUM U OF U GPA REQUIREMENT
- > IX TOTAL HOUR REQUIREMENT
 MINIMUM OF 122 CREDIT HOURS REQUIRED
- > UPPER DIVISION HOURS
 MINIMUM OF 40 UPPER DIVISION HOURS REQUIRED
 (3000 Level or Higher at U of U)
- > RESIDENCE HOUR REQUIREMENT

** This requirement is only relevant within the last **

** 30 hours prior to graduation **

Minimum GPA: keeps track of your cumulative GPA and if it is high enough to graduate

Total Hour: shows your progress towards the **122** credit hours required for graduation


Upper Division Hours: 40 of your total 122 hours must be courses of 3000 level or higher

Residence Hour: the last 30 credit hours you complete before graduation must be completed at the University of Utah






General Education Requirements
